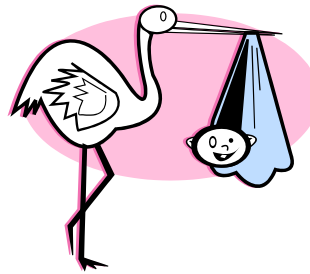


School's Out!
